

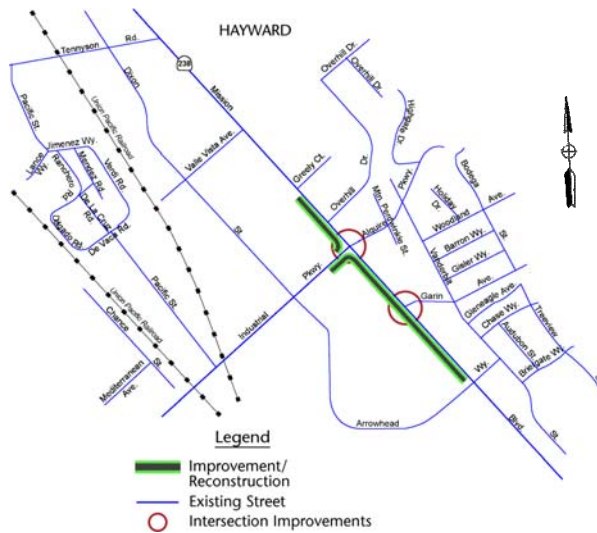

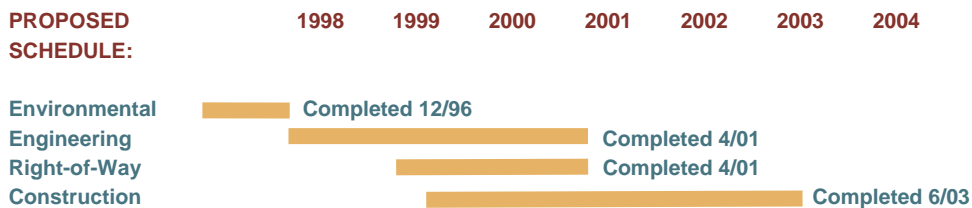

THE PROJECT included widening Mission Boulevard (Route 238) from four to six lanes between Industrial Parkway and Arrowhead Way and improving Industrial Parkway in the vicinity of the Mission Boulevard intersection.

THE COMPLETED PROJECT PROVIDES:

- Improved traffic flow and operations along Mission Boulevard between Industrial Parkway and Arrowhead Way
- Intersection improvements that increase capacity and safety through the Industrial Parkway intersection
- Improved bike and pedestrian access
- Beautification features including landscaping and stamped concrete in medians
