

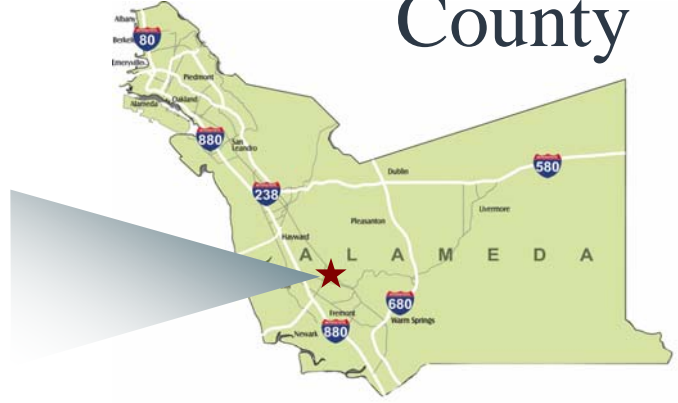
Union City Intermodal Station

E **HANCEMENTS** to the intermodal station at the Union City BART station, which currently serves BART, AC Transit, Union City Transit and the Dumbarton Express, will facilitate connections between existing and planned transit systems, the Capital Corridor, Altamont Commuter Express and the Dumbarton Commuter Rail — all at one location.

THE PROJECT includes transforming the existing one-sided BART Union City station to a two-sided station; improving pedestrian circulation; constructing a bus transit facility; improving local circulation; and reconfiguring the BART parking lot.



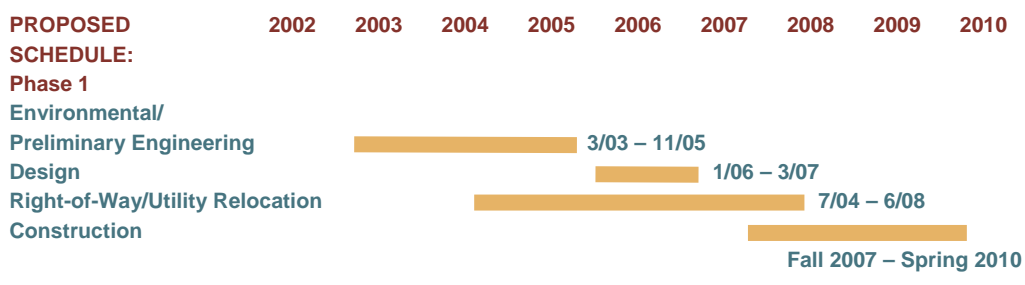
STATUS UPDATE:

Union City has obtained environmental clearance for the Redevelopment and General Plans around the station and for the rail component of the project. Construction of the related 11th Street Extension Project was completed in November 2005.

A construction contract for site improvements was awarded in March 2007. Construction began in Fall 2007 and is anticipated to be completed by Summer 2008. The station improvements contract was awarded in October 2007. Construction is anticipated to be completed by Spring 2010. ACTIA funds are being used for the above construction.

Final design for Phase II is being coordinated with the Dumbarton Rail Corridor Improvements and is not yet fully funded.
