



NOTICE OF CALL FOR PROJECTS

2006/2007 Measure B Bicycle/Pedestrian Countywide Discretionary Fund, Regional Bicycle & Pedestrian Program, and CMAQ Coordinated Program

Issue Date: October 27, 2006

For the 2006/2007 Coordinated Program, the following three funding sources are being coordinated into a single call for projects: Measure B Bicycle/Pedestrian Countywide Discretionary Fund (Measure B), Regional Bicycle & Pedestrian Program (RBPP), and CMAQ.

Bicycle and pedestrian projects, programs, and master plans are eligible to receive funding from these sources, as well as other projects that are eligible for CMAQ funds. The coordinated call for projects is intended to reduce the number of applications required from project sponsors and to bring all county-level programming for bicycle and pedestrian funding sources under a unified programming schedule.

The Alameda County Congestion Management Agency (ACCMA) and the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority (ACTIA) are requesting project submittals for the coordinated program. **Project applications (four copies) are due at the ACCMA Office, 1333 Broadway, Suite 220, Oakland, no later than 3:00 P.M., Friday, December 15, 2006.**

Application Workshop

A workshop will be held on **Monday, November 6, 2006 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** at the ACTIA Offices at 426 17th Street in Downtown Oakland.

The workshop will provide an overview of the 2006/2007 Coordinated Program, the application, and eligible project types. ACTIA and CMA staff will be available following the presentation to answer questions.

Funding Available

Approximately \$7.7 million will be available for programming between the three funding sources:

Measure B: \$3.0 million (discretionary)
RBPP: \$2.0 million (discretionary)
CMAQ: \$2.7 million (formula allocation)
Total: \$7.7 million
